Subject: Original engraving from the second half of the 20th century. Graphic art. Engraving - Joan Miró.

Publication: Gustavo Gili, 1975.

Technique: An etching engraved directly on copper plate by Joan Miró and printed under the direction of Joan Barbará. Limited edition of 273 copies. This engraving belongs to the number 185. Signed by Joan Miró in the print run justification of the work. Unsigned and unnumbered engraving.

Support: High quality paper fil Guarro.

Size: 50'5 x 36 cm.

Notes: Joan Miró illustrated in 1975 the poem *Càntic del sol*, translated into Catalan by Josep Carner, in a volume published by Gustavo Gili that contained 35 images. The poem of St. Francis of Assisi and the painting of the Catalan artist maintain a close affinity, both proclaim the solemn humility of the things of the earth, both, in very different cultural and spiritual worlds, offer us that presence and consistency without which the material and everyday seems superficial and anodyne.
